

GAS METERS SUITABLE FOR THE SAVEOMETER GAS TRANSMITTER

The **Elster BK series of meters** can be recognised by the letters BK found on the meter face. BK is usually, but not always followed by G1.6, or G2.5 or G4. This type of meter requires a special sensor which is supplied with each transmitter.

Actaris & Itron G4 or U6 meters are very similar – these excellent meters are both suitable. G4 or U6 shows as arrowed



George Wilson G4 meters are suitable in their newer versions only. To check if yours is a new version simply look under the display for a RJ11 socket (similar to a telephone socket). If your meter has this socket you can monitor gas using a new Saveometer gas transmitter

The Schlumberger & Actaris & Ugi Limited “R5” meters are all similar and have a distinctive R5 showing above the dials. (These are fairly old meters that usually measure gas in cubic feet & only have two red numbers)



Krom // Schroder BK-G4

This excellent German made gas meter has a clear display as shown here with the name Krom//Schroder shown at the top left hand side.
